RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT ("DISTRICT") ESTABLISHING MONTHLY RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR SOLID WASTE BY THE DISTRICT FOR A FIVE-YEAR PERIOD AND REPEALING ALL OTHER RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

WHEREAS, the Biola Community Services District previously established rates for solid waste furnished by the District; and

WHEREAS, the District desires to establish solid waste rates which are based on the actual and projected costs of providing services, including Prop 218 organic waste, between January of 2023 and January of 2028; and

WHEREAS, the Board has discussed the need for increased charges at various meetings regarding the potential rate increase; and

WHEREAS, the Board prepared and mailed a 45-day notice of public hearing to all customers and identified property owners served by the District, as required by Proposition 218; and

WHEREAS, the notice of public hearing included information on how and where to protest the proposed increase in solid waste service rates and the notice was developed in accordance with Proposition 218; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the proposed solid waste service charges is exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under California Public Resources Code Section 21080(b)(8); and

WHEREAS, the District held a public hearing on January 19, 2023, and considered all written protests and public comments regarding the proposed solid waste rates; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to proceed with the adoption of new solid waste and rates for a five-year period; and

WHEREAS, the rates for the five-year period are set forth in Attachment A to this resolution.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT finds, orders and resolves as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The solid waste fees are supported by an appropriate information and data provided to the Board.
- 3. No majority protest was presented against the proposed rates for solid waste services.

- 4. The adoption of the proposed solid waste rates is exempt from CEQA under California Public Resources Code Section 21080 (b)(8).
- 5. The monthly rates are adopted for a five-year period to be charged for the use of solid waste services furnished by the District enumerated in Attachment A to this Resolution, which is incorporated herein by reference, and may be automatically adjusted effective July 1 of each year, as determined by the percent increase in cost from the Mid Valley Disposal franchise agreement (set at the inflation rate) or current service provider, including landfill adjustments, not to exceed 10% annually and the cost of providing the service; and notice of any adjustment pursuant to the Schedule contained in Attachment A, shall be given not less than 30 days before the effective date of the adjustment.
- The newly adopted rates shall be made effective February 1, 2023.
- All other resolutions in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.
- This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.
