The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) is a U.S. government program run by the <u>Federal Communications</u> <u>Commission (FCC) program</u> to help low-income households pay for internet service and connected devices like a laptop or tablet. You are likely eligible if your household's income is below 200% of the Federal Poverty Line, or if you or someone you live with currently receives a government benefit like SNAP, Medicaid, SSI, WIC, Pell Grant, or Free and Reduced-Price Lunch.
