**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDING
FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT
FISCAL YEAR 2021-22**

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno receives an annual allocation of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and makes a portion of the funds available to agencies serving the unincorporated areas of the County; and;

WHEREAS, the Biola Community Services District is a participating agency and has been invited to apply for Fiscal Year 2021-22 CDBG funding by the County; and

WHEREAS, citizens of the Biola Community have met with the Board to discuss projects that are eligible for CDBG funding, and the majority were in favor of the construction of groundwater recharge facilities for the Biola Community Services District; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Submission of an application for CDBG funds for Fiscal Year 2021-22 to the County of Fresno for the construction of groundwater recharge facilities for the Biola Community Services District is hereby authorized.
2. The Interim General Manager is authorized to perform all necessary tasks and execute the application and all associated documents as required for CDBG funding.
