RESOLUTION NO 2022-19 A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BIOLA COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT APPROVING STUDENT ACCESS TO DISTRICT COMMUNITY CENTER DURING INCLEMENT AND HIGH TEMPERATURE WEATHER

WHEREAS, in 2023, District staff plans to work with Central Unified School District (CUSD) to improve school bus boarding locations and/or shelters for Biola Students. Before the matter is resolved, allow CUSD students access to the community center while waiting for buses in winter raining weather and in summer when the temperature is 100+ degrees; and

WHEREAS, Approximately 140+ students walk 1.5 to 2 miles each way throughout Biola in the heat and in winter weather to catch their respective Central Unified School District buses at 4925 N. Seventh Street & C Street (District Community Center)

WHEREAS, CUSD buses to and from the following campuses: Glacier Middle School, Justin Garza High School, Central High-East Campus, Central High-West Campus and Central Pershing; and

WHEREAS, for students to access the waiting location, parents would sign a liability waiver; students would have to adhere to strict guidelines of comportment and staff would post the time availability; and

WHEREAS, the Biola Community Services Board of Directors find it's in the best interest of District students to have a safe and comfortable environment.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Directors delegates the General Manager to implement the student assess program use during inclement weather and high heat advisory time periods and provide a status report in two months.
