SUBJECT: Mid-Valley Disposal Prop 218 (Initiation to notify the public)

SUMMARY:

This is an agenda “**action**” item that will be reviewed and approved to move forward and initiate a public hearing to notify the public of the initial increase of rates.

BACKGROUND:

The 1st Amendment to Municipal Solid Waste Franchise Agreement is made between Mid-Valley Disposal and Biola Community Services District for the 2021 agreement which was approved at the Regular Board Meeting September 15, 2022.

FINDINGS:

Beginning July 1, 2022, the following was Effective date of this Franchise agreement, the fee shall be annually adjusted upwards by adding a cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) to the then current fee. The (COLA) shall be based on the 80% of change in the annual consumer price index (CPI) plus 20% of the change in the tipping fees at the American Avenue Fees Landfill.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

1. Board of Directors to consider a date to have a public hearing for the public.
2. Board of Directors adopt Resolution No. 2022-14 Prop 218 Initiation to notify the public (Mid-Valley Disposal)
